## Classes

Instruction will be geared to those with little or no experience through to more advanced skill levels and will include:

- basic tool production w/associated heat treatments
- traditional forged motifs
- forge welding and the various joint types
- joining techniques
- a design and make project

The Blacksmith Camp is held at the Ness Creek Site near Big River, SK.
